RWU shall be the sole judge in the determination of these matters. RWU reserves the right to cancel this bid process and/or to

withhold the awarding of the bid as permitted by law. The actual award of a contract pursuant to this bid process is contingent on approval by the Rogers Waterworks and Sewer Commission.
